## 4.1 <u>Election of the Mayor</u>

The CEO conducted the election of the Mayor. Nominations were received as follows:

Crs McLennan and Wilding declined the nominations.

Mr Andrew Wilson conducted a secret ballot for the position of Mayor in accordance with the Local Government Act 1995 – Schedule 2.3.

Five votes were received for Cr Hamilton. Two votes were received for Cr Carter.

The CEO declared Cr Hamilton elected as Mayor.

Cr Hamilton made the Declaration of Office before Mr Michael Kar, JP.

Her Worship the Mayor, Cr Hamilton, took the Chair for the remainder of the meeting.

#### 5.1 <u>Public Question Time</u>

#### Mr Don Yates, 10 Thompson Road, Bassendean

Will the Council consider bringing forward the budget review to allow the new Councillors time to reflect and review the budget.

The Mayor responded that the Town's financial controller will be facilitating a review and workshop with Councillors on the Town's finances.

#### Mrs Anne Brinkworth, Ida Street, Bassendean

When will the Queen and flags be returned to the Chamber and why were they taken down.

Cr Hamilton advised that the Chamber was refurbished as it was looking dark and drab and old. The flags fly out the front of the Council building and it isn't necessary to have them inside the Chamber. The Queen and flags are on display at citizenship ceremonies. The Council may consider discussing this in the future.

#### Mr Terry Hall, Bassendean

The Council needs a better audio system so people can hear.

The Mayor advised that the current microphones are for audio recording of meetings but don't project the sound in the Chamber.

The CEO commented that the system is due to be upgraded this year.

#### Mr Bill Busby, 53 Hague Street, Bassendean
