

Call 9350 7195 to book a collection and place items on verge as directed.

Please remember to:

- Remove the door from fridges and freezers before placing on verge.
- Fridges and freezers do not need to be degassed prior to collection.
- Limit of 3 mattresses, lounges and fridges per year.

- Worm Farm + 1kg worms \$56.00
- 220L Compost Bin \$24.00

Cloth nappy & sanitary rebates

- Nappies up to \$100.00
- Sanitary up to \$50.00
