- The Town is dedicated to ensuring that our suburbs are safe, healthy and clean. To help us keep your street looking good, please place rubbish on your verge no earlier than the set-out dates indicated for your area. **Refer to the adjoining district map for the set-out dates in your area.**
- Bulk waste collections start at 7.00am on the Monday following your weekend set-out dates. **All waste must be out on the verge by this time as your street may be the first to be serviced. Allow up to 5 days for the collection.**
- Bulk waste deposited on the verge after the collection, is considered a litter offence.

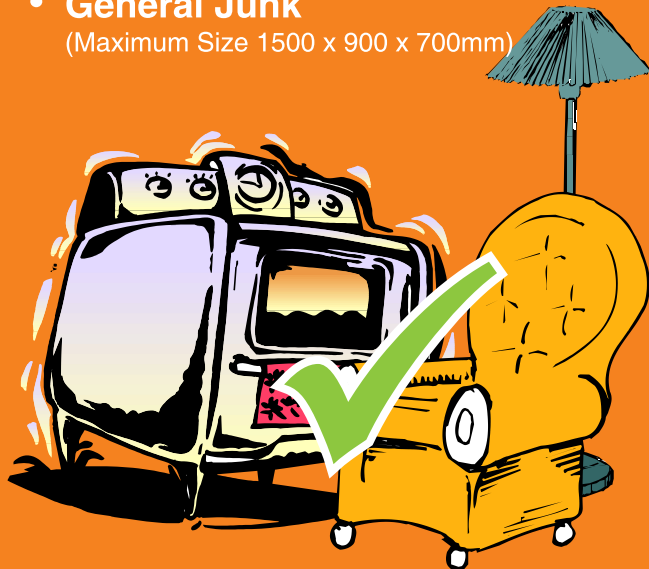

WILL REMOVE

- **Household Furniture**
- **White Goods/Metal Products***
(Stoves, Washing Machines, Air Conditioners)
**NOTE: Fridges and freezers to be collected during the Town's monthly collection service - Please call 9377 8000 to register a pick up.*
- **Timber Products**
(Maximum Size 1500 x 900 x 700mm and place separately from other items)
- **General Junk**
(Maximum Size 1500 x 900 x 700mm)

There are a number of permanent drop off facilities throughout Perth for residents to safely dispose of hazardous items which must not go into your green-top rubbish bin. It is free to take a combined total of 20kg/20L maximum of items.

To make collection easier, please note the following **IMPORTANT CONDITIONS...**

- **DO NOT** place your **BULK RUBBISH** on the verge until the weekend set-out dates shown in your area.
- Place Bulk Rubbish **NEATLY** on the verge so that it does not obstruct the line of sight of pedestrians, cyclists or motorists.
- **PLEASE KEEP THE WASTE CLEAR OF** sprinkler systems, water meters, power poles, street signs or utility boxes as these may be damaged during the collection process.
- **DO NOT** obstruct the footpath or your normal bin service.
- Spiked or sharp items must be contained or protected to avoid injury. Small items must be boxed or bagged.
- Residents are requested to clean up any minor spillage which remains after the pickup.
- No returns will be made to a street for junk put out late.
- Waste left on the verge which is not collected by contractor must be removed within seven days or a fine may be issued.
