To assist the Town of Bassendean residents keep their property safe, the following information on private residential CCTV has been extracted from the Office of Crime Prevention publication: Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Technical Advice.

“Many individuals and families are now choosing to install CCTV as part of their home security systems. The large range of relatively inexpensive do-it-yourself CCTV installation kits has made the use of CCTV a much more attractive and popular option for modern home security.

The installation and use of CCTV should, however, be based on the outcomes of a well considered risk assessment and home owners should become familiar with any legislation regulating the use of devices such as CCTV.”

Should owners of private residences wish to install CCTV, the technical advice provided in the Office of Crime Prevention publication: Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Technical Advice, (page 49) may assist with selection of a system that may provide an appropriate level of quality for their needs.
