#### 8.1 Local Studies Librarian's Report

#### **GENERAL**

The Local Studies Librarian attended the book launch for Gina Williams' song Wanjoo, at Bassendean Memorial Library on 20 May 2017 with Councillors, staff, invited guests, staff and students from Ashfield Primary School, Guy Ghouse and members of the community.

The Annual Library History Lecture, organised by the Local Studies Librarian, took place on 14 June and was presented by former Mayor and local author Mr Bevan Carter. Mr Carter spoke about the Aboriginal history of Bassendean. Approximately 40 people attended, with questions and discussion at the conclusion. The lecture supported the Reconciliation Action Plan of the Town of Bassendean and raised awareness of local history and the Local Studies Collection. Attendees received a 'gift bag' of Library publications and promotional material about the NAIDOC event hosted by the Town of Bassendean.

The Local Studies Librarian has attended three Reconciliation Action Plan working group meetings with consultants David Ashton and Christine Sindely and colleagues from the Town of Bassendean.

The Local Studies Librarian has provided biographical information to planning colleagues about the Abell and McKinlay families prior to proposed naming of the respective reserve and laneway in the Town of Bassendean.

### **VOLUNTEERS**

Four valued volunteers continue to assist the Local Studies Librarian with administrative tasks including the rates book index project, filing, genealogical research and the provision of the monthly guided walk.

#### WEBSITE AND FACEBOOK

The Local Studies Librarian continues to provide ongoing information about street naming origins and photographs and information for Tuesday Treasures on the Library Facebook page.

#### TRAINING/PLANNING/PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

The Local Studies Librarian attended following training and professional development events:

- Australian Library and Information Association (WA Branch) Leadership event at the State Library on 19 May, with guest speakers Dr Carmen Lawrence, former Premier of WA, and Jennifer Nicholson, former secretary of International Federation of Library Associations.
- WA State Heritage and History Conference on 11-12 May at Perth Concert Hall, hosted by the City of Perth and State Heritage Office. With four concurrent sessions, it was often a difficult choice of which speaker to attend. It was an ideal networking opportunity and both interesting and inspiring to learn about developments in other organizations and collections. The pre- conference excursion included visits to the Perth City Library and Local History Collection, the State Records Office and Battye Library.

- The Trove Roadshow by the National Library at the State Library of Western Australia on 8 June. As a result, The Local Studies Librarian has created over thirty five lists on a variety of topics, places and people relevant to Bassendean. This allows people anywhere to access information about local places, persons or groups at a single link on Trove- collating information for easy access regardless of its format or location.
- Driver awareness training at the Town of Bassendean on 31 May, a one day course aimed to increase awareness of safety practices when driving vehicles at the Town of Bassendean.

#### VISITS/OUTREACH

The Local Studies Librarian attended following events and meetings:

- The Danjoo Koorliny Reconciliation event at Mary Crescent Gathering Site on 25 May. It was an opportunity to communicate with local members of the aboriginal community and to observe the annual ceremonial tree planting and support the Town of Bassendean' Reconciliation Action Plan.
- As a guest speaker at the Bassendean Over 55's lunch on 28 June. This was an opportunity to promote the Local Studies Collection and provide information in the form of a local history quiz. Participants viewed photographs needing identification and assisted with information where possible.
- Visit to the Bassendean Bowling Club in order to become familiar with the wealth of information about the history of the club contained within the building as part of ongoing relationships with community groups.

The Local Studies Librarian contributed to the Library's display about Jane Austen (to mark 200 years since her death.)
