# **BOOKED SKIP BINS & ITEM COLLECTIONS**

# Skip bins

We are aiming to move to a pre-booked loose verge collection from 1 January 2026. From July- December 2025, residents will have an allocation of 1 skip bin (either general waste or green waste). Skip bins are:

1.8m long x 1.65m wide x 1.2m tall

#### Mattresses, fridges and lounges

Each financial year, residents can book up to three (3) on-demand item collections for mattresses, fridges/freezers or lounges.

- Remove doors from fridges and freezers before placing on the verge
- Service Fridges and freezers do not need to be degassed prior to collection


