GREEN WASTE COLLECTION 2020

The Town is dedicated to ensuring that our suburbs are safe, healthy and clean. To help us keep your street looking good, please place green waste on your verge **no earlier than the set-out dates** indicated for your area. Refer to the adjoining Town map for the set-out dates in your area.

Green waste collections start at 7.00am on the Monday following your weekend set-out dates. All green waste must be out on the verge by this time as your street may be the first to be serviced. Allow up to 5 days for the collection.

Green waste placed on the verge before set-out date or after the collection, is considered a littering offence. Offenders may be issued an infringement.

ITEMS COLLECTED

Tree prunings

Maximum length 1500 mm x 200 mm diameter

Palm fronds

Maximum length 1500 mm x 200 mm diameter

Creepers and vines

Tree stumps

Maximum length 1500 mm x 200 mm diameter

Loose leaves

Cardboard boxed only to a maximum 32kg

Succulents

Cardboard boxed only

Bamboo

Maximum length 1500mm x 200mm diameter

Tree prunings with thorns

Lawn clippings

Cardboard boxed only to a maximum 32kg

ITEMS NOT COLLECTED

**This is not a bulk hard waste collection.
Check the Town's website for hard waste
collection dates.**

We will not collect:

- ✗ Sand or soil
- ✗ Green waste in bags or containers other than cardboard boxes
- ✗ General rubbish
- ✗ Stumps exceeding the maximum length
- ✗ Treated timber

IMPORTANT CONDITIONS

- Place green waste neatly, a minimum of 1m back from the verge, so that it does not obstruct the footpath or the line of sight for road users.
- Please keep green waste clear of sprinkler systems, water meters, power poles, street signs or utility boxes to avoid any damage during collection.
- To avoid injury, spiked or sharp items must be contained or protected. Small items must be placed in cardboard boxes.
- We will not collect from vacant lots, reserves or parks and properties not receiving a domestic waste collection service.
- It is your responsibility to tidy the area of any remaining material after collection.
- **NO RETURNS WILL BE MADE FOR GREEN WASTE SET OUT LATE.**
