





Economic Report Card Town of Bassendean



Manufacturing, Mining and Wholesale Trade cover **77.4%** of exported goods.




Total domestic imports for Bassendean from the rest of Australia are estimated at **\$675.639 million**.


Highest local demand sectors; Manufacturing, Construction, Rental Hiring and Real Estate.

The Town has **7.04%** of residents who work and live in the Town. Job Sufficiency in other areas of Perth's Eastern Region:


