Dear Local Government Chief Executive Officer,

### **Important change to the Construction Training Fund Levy**

I am writing to inform you of an important update regarding the Construction Training Fund levy (also known as the BCITF levy).

For projects starting construction **on or after 1 July 2026**, the **estimated** value of **construction work** to which the Construction Training Fund levy applies will increase from **\$20,000 to \$100,000**.

For projects that start construction **before 1 July 2026**, the threshold will stay at **\$20,000**.

This change is designed to improve efficiency, reduce administrative requirements and support businesses as they manage rising cost pressures.

For Local Governments that collect the levy on behalf of the CTF or require levy payment receipts for building applications, this change will reduce the payment verifications or remittances needed and increase the efficiency of the process.


The levy will continue to help train the skilled workers we need to build the homes, infrastructure and projects that keep the state moving through our extensive training, apprentice, promotion and upskilling initiatives.

**No other aspect of the levy will change.**
