Place two bins out for collection each week:



Keep bins one metre clear of obstructions (e.g. cars, poles) and within one metre of the road.

- RECYCLING (yellow lid) + FOGO (lime-green lid) week
- GENERAL WASTE (red lid) + FOGO (lime-green lid) week
- Bins collected a day later due to public holiday.
- Additional collections, all three bins collected.

FOGO BIN Lime-green Lid COLLECTED WEEKLY

Food only and garden only with compostable liners with the seedling logo should be placed in this bin.



Food scraps



Vegetable and fruit scraps



Compostable liners only



Garden organics



Earth-cycle organics back into compost!

Food scraps and garden waste are turned into recycled organics, such as compost. These are used in agriculture, urban amenity and by local governments and households.

RECYCLING BIN Yellow Lid COLLECTED FORTNIGHTLY

Place all items loose in the bin. Flatten cardboard, rinse containers and remove lids.



Glass bottles and jars (lids off)



Plastic bottles and containers (lids off)



Cardboard (flattened)



Paper (not shredded)



Cans



Recyclables

Recycle the five!

Keep it simple and remember these 5: paper, cardboard, cans, plastic and glass.

GENERAL WASTE BIN Red Lid COLLECTED FORTNIGHTLY

General household waste items are to be placed in this bin.



Soft plastics



Kitty litter



Takeaway food packaging and cups



Soiled paper and cardboard



Damaged clothing and ceramics



Nappies, hygiene products



General waste

Avoid excess packaging

Some items can't be recovered by gifting, recycling or other means. We can do better than the bin by AVOIDING these items in the first place! Get back into good habits.

WHERE DO THEY GO?

These are the items that most often mistakenly end up in the wrong bins!
