


### **FOGO BIN** Lime-green Lid COLLECTED WEEKLY

Only use compostable caddy liners (available from the Town) that are certified under Australian Standards. Look for the seedling logo.

### **RECYCLING BIN** Yellow Lid COLLECTED FORTNIGHTLY

Place all items loose into the bin.

## **Cloth Nappies and Sanitary Items Rebate**

### What you can claim

Cloth nappies- 50% of the purchase price to a maximum amount of \$100.

Reusable sanitary products- 50% of the purchase price to a maximum amount of \$50.

### How to apply

To be eligible for the nappy rebate you must attend a workshop. We want to make sure you have the best opportunity for success in using your new nappies.

## Composting

The Town provides a subsidy to its residents to encourage home composting and the improvement of local soils. The above systems can be purchased through the Town at 40% of their retail value.

In order to be eligible for the subsidy you must be a Town of Bassendean resident. A limit of one system per household applies.



## **Bulk Verge Collections & Drop Off Mornings**

The verge collections scheduled for October/ November 2022 and April/May 2023 are cancelled ahead of the Town's transition to a booked skip bin service launch.

Please do not place material out for these cancelled collections.

### MATTRESSES, FRIDGES AND FREEZERS

Call 9350 7195 to book a collection and place items on verge as directed.

Please remember to:

- Remove the door from fridges and freezers before placing on verge.
- Fridges and freezers do not need to be degassed prior to collection.
- Limit of 3 mattresses J per household per year.

The Town is transitioning to a booked Skip Bin service. There are multiple benefits to an on-demand Skip Bin service such as convenience and reduced dumpina.

From Thursday 10 November 2022 residents will be able to order one general waste skip bin, and one green waste skip bin per financial year. The first bins are to be delivered on Thursday 1 December 2022. Alternatively, residents can also choose to order two green waste skip bins per financial year.

Where a verge is not suitable for a skip bin, residents may be eligible for a bin to be emptied from private property with the signing of a waiver and approval from Veolia. If this is not possible, then a booker verge collection may be offered based on an assessment by Veolia. If all the previous methods are not viable, the Town may elect to provide 2 additional tip vouchers.

### COMMUNITY DROP OFF MORNINGS

When: 15th of October 2022 and 6th of May 2023 (both Saturdays) 9.00am - 12.00pm Dates and times are subject to change.

Location: 69 Scaddan Street, Bassendean

Accepted items: Non painted/untreated timber, tyres (off rim), metal, cardboard, household batteries, engine oil (20L max), polystyrene, aerosols and E-waste.

#### Waste accepted:

Televisions, computers and computer accessories (whole, unbroken items only) - No commercial quantities

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). Do not mix with general waste or recyclables (maximum 20kg or 20lt).

General waste (fee payable)

Asbestos (fee payable) - Must be twice-wrapped in thick plastic and taped.

#### Tip Passes

Each residential property that pays for a waste service in the Town of Bassendean is entitled to two (2) tip passes per financial vear.\*

Each tip pass entitles the owner to dispose of up to half a tonne of waste equal to 1.8m x 1.2m trailer or ute.\*\*

#### Please note:

Tip passes are not for resale and are unable to be replaced if disposed of or lost.

\* Tip passes able to be redeemed at Baywaste from 1/09/2022

\*\* Fee payable for tip passes redeemed at Baywaste
