

Thanks to residents using their FOGO bins correctly, the kerbside recovery rate is now at **54%** vs this time last year at 15%. Since introducing the FOGO system the Town has diverted **1,966 tonnes** of FOGO from the red lid bin.

MATTRESSES. FRIDGES AND FREEZERS

Please remember to:

- Remove the door from fridges and freezers before placing on verge.
- Fridges and freezers do not need to be degassed prior to collection.
- Limit of 3 mattresses per household per year.

Each tip pass entitles the owner to dispose of up to half a tonne of waste equal to 1.8m x 1.2m trailer or ute.
