



Waste accepted and fees:

General waste: Fee payable.

Asbestos: Fee payable. Must be wrapped in plastic sheeting and taped.

Television and computer recycling:

No charge for old computers and televisions. "Whole" products only accepted. CRT's out of casing or cracked / broken are not able to be accepted.

Household Hazardous Waste only: No charge for household quantities (no larger than 20kg / 20L per material type). Mixed waste (HHW and / or recyclables with general waste) will incur a fee.

Tip passes

Each property that pays for a rubbish service in the Town of Bassendean is entitled to four (4) tip passes each financial year.

Attached to the current Rate Notice is the 2019/2020 rubbish tip passes valid until 31 July 2020. These passes entitle the rate payer to dispose of waste at Red Hill Waste Management Facility to a maximum of half a tonne (1.8m x 1.2m trailer or utility) per tip pass.

Tip passes are no longer available from Council Administration Centre or Library.

The tip passes are not for resale.
