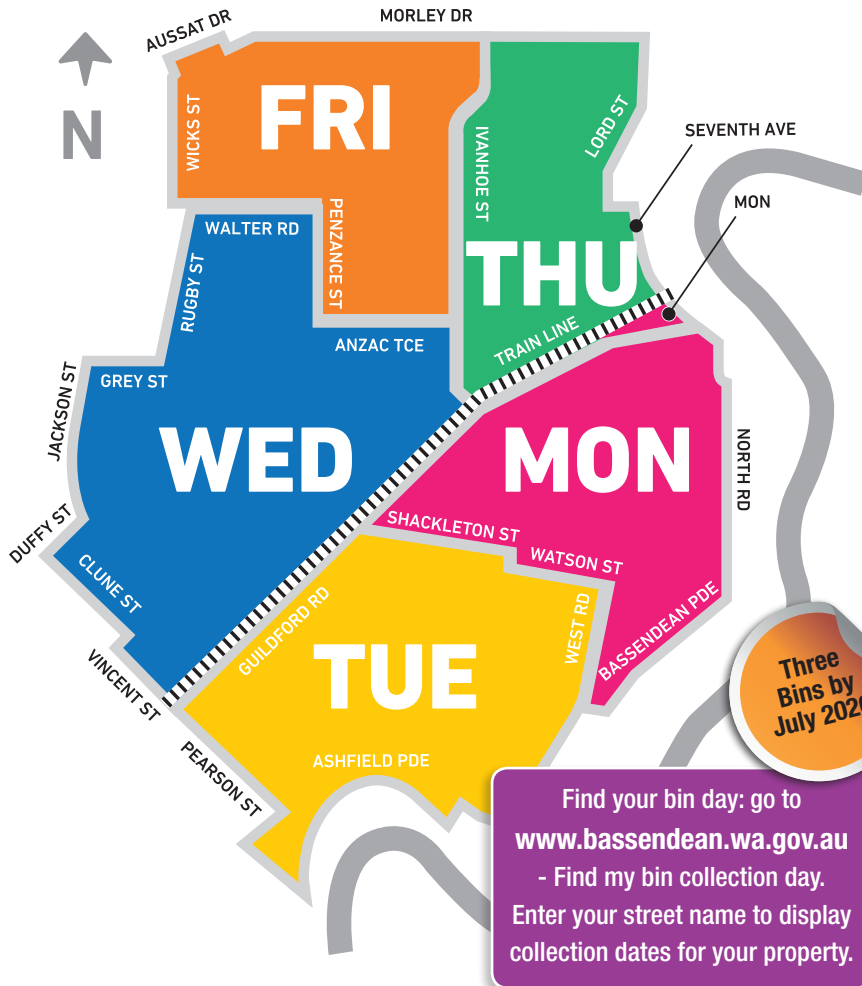

Verge Collections & Drop Off Mornings

Maximum of two cubic metres
per verge collection
(equivalent of two 1.8 x 1.2m trailer loads)



Place your waste on the verge only on the indicated weekend set-out dates.

Rangers will inspect the area to ensure that items are not placed out earlier than the dates below or after the collection dates. Infringements may be imposed.

Collections will start at 7:00 am on the Monday following your weekend set-out dates.

Mixed Greenwaste Verge Collection

- » Tree prunings (maximum length 1.5 m x 200 mm diameter) ✓
- » Palm fronds (maximum length 1.5 m x 200 mm diameter) ✓
- » Creepers and Vines ✓
- » Tree stumps (maximum length 1.5 m and 200 mm in diameter) ✓
- » Tree leaves (in cardboard boxes only, to maximum 32kgs) ✓
- » Succulents (in cardboard boxes only, to maximum 32kgs) ✓
- » Bamboo ✓
- » Tree prunings with thorns ✓
- » Lawn clippings (in cardboard boxes only, to maximum 32kgs) ✓
- » NO greenwaste in containers or bags other than cardboard boxes ✗
- » NO plastic bags or plastic containers ✗
- » NO branches / stumps exceeding a maximum length 1.5m x 200mm diameter ✗
- » NO junk ✗
- » NO Dirt, soil or sand ✗
- » NO Rocks, bricks, rubble or limestone blocks ✗
- » NO treated pine or stained timber ✗

There are a number of hazardous items which must not be placed in your bins. These hazardous items can be taken to any permanent HHW facility, such as the Red Hill Waste Management Facility. It is free of charge to take 20kg / 20L per material type.

to be accepted.

Household Hazardous Waste only:

No charge for household quantities (no
larger than 20kg / 20L per material type).
Mixed waste (HHW and / or recyclables
with general waste) will incur a fee.

Tip passes

Each property that pays for a rubbish
service in the Town of Bassendean
is entitled to four (4) tip passes each
financial year.

Attached to the current Rate Notice is the
2019/2020 rubbish tip passes valid until
31 July 2020. These passes entitle the rate
payer to dispose of waste at Red Hill Waste
Management Facility to a maximum of half
a tonne (1.8m x 1.2m trailer or utility) per
tip pass.

Tip passes are no longer available from
Council Administration Centre or Library.

The tip passes are not for resale.
