I do not recommend either of the options outlined above. Making a decision on this seems premature until the City of Swan provide further details regarding their intentions to make Lord Street a dual carriageway to Guildford Road by 2022, at which time the Town of Bassendean has signalled intent to work with the City of Swan to produce a concept design of the Lord Street upgrade extension and any plans for Success Hill intersection. Council minutes dated October 2017 recommend the matter is deferred pending the results of the study, at which time a report will be presented to Council following community consultation. It is an inefficient approach to utilise council time and resources on a short term solution to a perceived traffic challenge, which in reality is no different to the difficulty any resident of any neighbourhood faces turning right onto a main road in peak traffic, until the long term plans for traffic management in the area are known.




There is no problem at this intersection. There is a slight delay at peak times (1 min maybe, with 2 or 3 cars stacked - at the very very worst) which is understandable and expected in a city environment in 2018. For the 95% remainder of the time it is virtually empty (as the vehicle volumes demonstrate). There is plenty of room for a vehicle turning right into Success Rd from Lord St to be passed as I have experienced thousands of time. This is a non-issue, and not something (in my opinion) the ToB should be investing funds into. Instead the ToB should invest funds and resources into improving the pedestrian environment on Lord Street and actively engaging MRWA and WAPC to retain Lord Street as a two lane road (disincentivising car use, thus encouraging active transport modes instead). Scarborough Beach Road in Mount Hawthorn is a similar width with similar volumes but has footpaths, verges, medians, street trees and as a result encourages pedestrians and cyclists reducing the amount of vehicles on the surrounding roads. This should be the proactive focus of council and would be greatly appreciated and supported by many local Success Hill residents.

In 1989 I lived at 40 Lord St, adjacent to this intersection so am familiar with it. That house no longer exists as it was owned by (what is now) WAPC for future widening of Lord St, the future of which has still never been clarified to the satisfaction of Bassendean residents. I have been employed nearly a decade driving around Perth & surrounds and have driven every road, some many times and at all times of day, so am cognisant of road & traffic issues. I see no value in "opening up" the Walter Rd E cul de sac. The intersection is on a crest, a "blind hill" and the current configuration of traffic lights with overhead light is the safest yet at that site. It would be virtually impossible to roundabout here with safe sight lines & camber, and would create an extra risk & unnecessary hindrance to North South flow. The Success Hill precinct is small and not suited to residential intensification due to heavy clay soil (poor drainage, expensive builds), proximity to river and access / egress issues. If this intersection were 'opened up', it would most likely end up a 'rat run' with associated hazards. The main traffic problems in this area are due to an increased "rush hour" load along Lord St, which alteration to this intersection would do nothing to mitigate. Even if a traffic light were to allow left turn out from Walter Rd E, this would only benefit a very small number of people while causing disruption to many more. Until the widening (or not) of Lord St has been confirmed it is folly to do anything here.







As someone who has cycled between Bassendean south and Success Hill frequently, but slowly and carefully, I can say that there is no point building a cycle path here. The road is virtually free of traffic, quiet, offers clear visibility and is at a grade which would not be any better via the cycle way proposed. Indeed the clarity of vision and clear space of the road itself provides a safer travel in the case of any unexpected obstructions. Bicycles cannot stop quickly going downhill. A tight curving path is not appreciated either up or down. Creating such a thing here is a waste of money, and no doubt would result in the loss of many valuable amenity trees as has occurred with other similar "shared paths". Even if such a path were constructed, I would prefer to ride on this stretch of road, lest I happen across an unwary pedestrian, child or someone walking dogs on the 'shared' path. Instead provide ramps where kerbs are too high for bicycles and prams. Leave the shade trees in place. Instead - if money must be spent, calm the vehicular traffic, what little there is of it.

Nothing needs to be done. There is insufficient reason to make more access/egress points and it is an uncalled for and unnecessary expense the Town does not need to bear. There are limited limited accidents at Success Rd/Lord St. Any inconvenience faced entering onto Lord Street is experienced only at peak times and is experienced by all local residents using that section of Lord Street - those on the west side of Lord Street have three times as many options to enter onto Lord Street as the Success Hill residents but still face the same problem - i.e., the peak-time volume of traffic on Lord Street. No amount of extra access points onto Lord Street diminishes that problem. It is important to note through that this volume of traffic is currently inflated because of the works on Tonkin Highway. Over and above the unnecessary expense, reopening Walter Road in any way is not advisable. Making it exit only will mean the northern residents of Walter Road cannot have their bins collected as service vehicles will not be able to turn around. There is already significantly more residents on Walter Road than on Success Road and there is need for onstreet parking by residents and visitors who use the nearby bushland. Forcing 500 vehicles per day around the 90degree corner of Walter and Seventh onto what is a vastly more densely populated road than Success seems impractical, dangerous and incredibly lacking in care and concern for the safety of residents, their personal choice to live in a secluded cul de sac and the inevitable diminution in their amenity and capacity to enjoy their lives in what is a quiet and secluded area. Pushing more traffic up Seventh Avenue across the 5-way Success Road/7th/8th intersection is clearly inadvisable as traffic travelling north across that intersection has extremely limited visibility (part of the reason Walter Road was closed initially). The minimal

inconvenience faced by car users at peak times is vastly outweighed by the inconvenience the residents of Seventh Avenue and Walter Road will be put to. Directing 500-odd cars per day past the only entrance to the local park and playground is also inadvisable. If the Town is serious about supporting infill measures and minimising car dependency, it will encourage the current use of Walter Road and Seventh Avenues as pedestrian paths of choice for people wishing to access the local bushland and pedestrians and cyclists making their way to the train station rather than walking or riding on the vastly busier Lord Street.


