COMMUNITY SAFETY STATEMENT

In July 2020, Council adopted a new Strategic Community Plan (SCP), which defines the Town's vision, aspirations and priorities for the next 10 years. It is the key guiding document that informs all other plans, strategies and policies and the Town's actions and decisions.

One of the seven priority areas is "Strengthening and Connecting our Community", which seeks to create an environment where people feel safe and welcomed, and the Town recognises that safety and security, both actual and perceived, are essential to fostering a sense of wellbeing and place.

Whilst the SCP is a high-level, strategic document, it clearly demonstrates the Town's desire for a safe environment and connected community, in which we all have a part to play. Facilitate Community Connections

Community connection is crucial in reducing crime in our neighbourhoods. It's important that we get to know our neighbours and look out for each other to help reduce the impacts of unwanted antisocial behaviour. Therefore, the Town will continue to support the community in various ways to encourage strong bonds, networks and connections.

Maintain and improve our public spaces

We will make and maintain inviting, thriving and well-lit spaces where people will want to gather and enjoy all our community has to offer whilst respecting their surroundings. We will work to reduce the level of graffiti in our public spaces and will promptly remove any graffiti or vandalism that does occur.

Partner with WA Police

The Town will continue to work in partnership with with WA Police, organisations and businesses to improve and promote community safety by providing information and assistance where we can to help prevent and solve crimes within our community. The Town will continue partnering with the Constable Care program through local schools to teach our young people about personal and community safety.

Support the growth of our community

More people living and working within the Town means more opportunities for passive surveillance and activity on our streets. This is why we have developed the Town Centre Masterplan, to encourage more residential and business opportunities in the Bassendean town centre, leading to an increase in population over time.

This will lead to the creation of even more inviting, thriving and well-lit spaces where people will want to gather and enjoy all our community has to offer which will increase actual and perceived safety. This will contribute to our shared goal of a connected and engaged community as we work together to make our streets safer.
